

The Academy is organizing a three day course on 'Gender Budgeting' for the IPS officers of the rank of ASP to DIG and equivalent rank officers from other All India Services of IFS/IAS/IFoS/ IC & CES, IRS (IT) and Officers from CAPFs (Direct recruited officers of 5-20 years of service).

2. SVP NPA is conducting the aforesaid course under the Gender Budgeting Scheme of Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India. The Workshop/course proposed by SVP National Police Academy can play an important role in building domain knowledge and capabilities in Gender Budgeting among important public services of the country. It would enhance the gender perspective in planning, budgetary and implementation processes in government departments. The proposed workshop would build awareness about the importance and need for gender budgeting in government department, develop skills in using gender budgeting tools in officers particularly those who are in positions where budgetary planning and analysis is done.

3. Subjects/contents which will be covered in the course are :

- Concept of Gender and implications for governments
- Gender Budgeting: Concepts, Principles and Processes
- Budget formats and processes
- Tools for Gender Budget Analysis
- Experiences of Gender Budgeting Initiatives
- Gender Responsive Budgeting.

4. In view of the importance of the course, it is requested to nominate two *eligible officers as main and one reserve from each State/UT/Organization for the said course.*


5. **The nominations for the course may please be sent to the Academy latest by 15th February, 2017 through Fax (040-24015179) / E-mail (seniorcourse@svpnpa.gov.in) for acceptance and forwarding joining instructions to the nominated officers directly. The postal address, telephone / mobile number, fax number & E-Mail ID of the nominated officers along with their batch seniority may also be intimated. 6. The course is residential and the participants of the course will be accommodated in the campus. **The expenditure to be incurred on board and lodging of the participants shall be met by the Academy.** However, the expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the course may be borne by the respective state Government / organization. It is also reiterated that as per SOP of the Academy, **nominations of only those Officers who have not undergone any Course (except ITC/MCTP) in this Academy during the 12 months preceding the start of the course on 'Gender Budgeting' shall be accepted.** In addition, as per SOP of the Academy, those Officers against whom criminal case, DE/PE etc. is in currency or contemplated are also **not eligible** to undergo any training programme/workshop at the Academy. Hence, nominations of Officers may be sent accordingly.

7. The dress order for the participants is Civvies i.e. shirt (full sleeves), Trouser & tie for gentlemen and Salwar Kammez/ Saree/ Business Suit for ladies.

8. **The nominees may be advised to proceed for the training course only after receiving confirmation of acceptance of their nominations from the Academy.** The officers whose nominations accepted are required to report at the Academy by the evening of 14th March, 2017 i.e. one day before the commencement of the training course. Transport from Hyderabad Airport / railway station to the Academy and back will be provided by the Academy.
