Applications are invited from Indian Citizens for filling up the following posts of Group-'A' Gazetted (Combatised) in Sashastra Seema Bal, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India on deputation/re-employment basis.

1. **Additional Judge Attorney General : 2(two) nos.**
(Commandant)
2. **Deputy Judge Attorney General : 4(four) nos.**
(Deputy Commandant)

2. The details of above posts are furnished as under:-

I) Eligibility condition for the post of Additional Judge Attorney General (Commandant):

By deputation/absorption:

(a) Officers of the Central Government or State Government or Union Territories or Central Armed Police Forces including Sashastra Seema Bal, having a degree in law from a recognised University or equivalent:

(i) holding analogous post in the Pay Band – 4 (₹37,400–67,000) with grade pay of ₹8700 or equivalent on regular basis in the parent cadre or department, having fifteen years of experience in dealing with legal matters or court cases; or

(ii) with five years' regular service in the grade of Pay Band-3 (₹15600-39100) with grade pay of ₹7600, having fifteen years of experience in dealing with legal matters/ court cases; or

(iii) with ten years regular service in the grade of Pay Band–3 (₹15,600–39,100) with grade pay of ₹6600, having fifteen years experience in dealing with legal matters or court cases; or

(b) an officer who is a member of the State Judicial Service holding analogous post in the Pay Band-4 (₹37,400 – 67,000) with grade pay of ₹8700 or equivalent having fifteen years of experience in dealing with legal matters or court cases.

Note-1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note-2: The period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same Organisation or Department shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note-3: The Upper age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of receipt of application.

Note-4: For the purposes of appointment on deputation or absorption basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission except, where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post or posts for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up gradation.

For Ex-Servicemen Deputation or re-employment.

The Armed Forces officers in the rank of Colonel or Lieutenant Colonel, due to retire or who are to be transferred to reserve within a period of one year, shall also be considered. Such officers shall be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release or superannuation from the Armed Forces; thereafter they may continue on re-employment. (Re-employment up to the age of superannuation with reference to the post in the organization.)

Should be in the medical Category SHAPE-I

II) Eligibility condition for the post of Deputy Judge Attorney General (Deputy Commandant):

By deputation/absorption:

Officers of the Central Government or State Government or Union Territories or Central Armed Police Forces including Sashastra Seema Bal, having a degree in Law from a recognized University or equivalent:

(i) holding analogous post in the Pay Band – 3 (₹15,600 – 39,100) with grade pay of ₹6600, on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or

(ii) an officer who is a member of the State Judicial Service holding analogous post in the Pay Band-3 (₹15,600 – 39,100) with grade pay of ₹6600, having six years of experience dealing with legal matters/court cases; or

(iii) with six years regular service in the grade of Assistant Commandant or equivalent in the Pay Band – 3 (₹15,600 – 39,100) with grade pay of ₹5400. Having five years' of experience in dealing with legal matters/court cases.

Note-1: The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for appointment on deputation, similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note-2: The period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same Organisation or Department shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note-3: The Upper age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of receipt of application.

For Ex-Servicemen deputation or re-employment.

By deputation or re-employment of released or retired Armed Forces Officers in the rank of Major or equivalent in the Department of Judge Advocate General in Army/ Navy/Air Force.

Note-: The Armed Forces Officers due to retire or who are to be transferred to reserve within a period of one year, shall also be considered. Such officers shall be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release or superannuation from the Armed Forces; thereafter they may continue on re-employment. (Re-employment upto the age of superannuation with reference to the post in the organisation.)

Should be in the Medical category SHAPE-I.
