Dear Sir,

The National Human Rights Commission, a statutory body established under the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993 is responsible for promotion and protection of human rights. Among other functions, conducting inquiry into the complaints of human rights violations is one of the prime responsibilities of the Commission. The Investigation Division of the Commission, headed by an officer of the rank of Director General of Police, assists the Commission in collection of facts, conduct of enquiries, scrutinizing of various reports and analytical examination of the complaints of custodial violence, deaths in police and judicial custody including deaths in encounters.

Inspectors of the Investigation Division are vital functionaries of Division and are responsible for conducting enquiries into complaints relating to human rights (under the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993), for such abuses and violations like torture, illegal detention, extra-judicial killings, false implication in criminal cases, intimidation, harassment, bonded & child labour, denial of basis rights to women, children, prisoners and weaker sections of society.

The Commission appoints Inspectors as investigation officers in the Investigation Division on transfer on deputation basis from time to time as per the vacancies. The total sanctioned strength of Inspectors is 20 and out of these, 5 posts are vacant. In this connection, a copy of notified Recruitment Rules of the Commission for the post of Inspectors is enclosed herewith for your reference.
